Explain the aim of the unit (as above). Begin a class discussion of the familiar fairytale, Little Red Riding Hood and recap the plot using the picture cards. If pupils are not familiar with the story, it may be worth reading it in English first. Use 'Caperucita Roja (1)' PowerPoint to introduce the new language consisting of nouns and determiners for a variety of characters and objects that feature in the story of Little Red Riding Hood. Activity: In pairs, children use the picture cards to try and remember as much of the vocabulary from today as possible.
