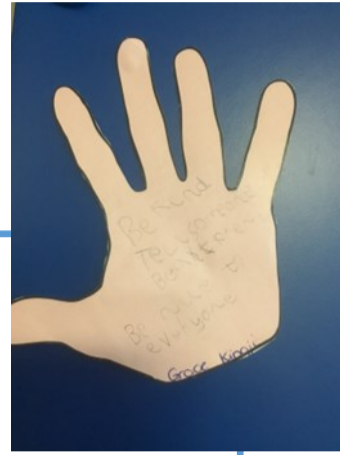

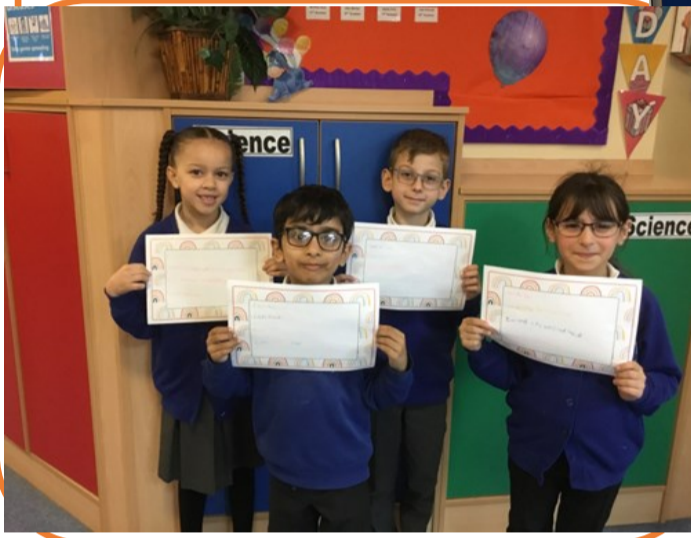

Pupils spent some time this week thinking about the things that make them feel good as well dis-

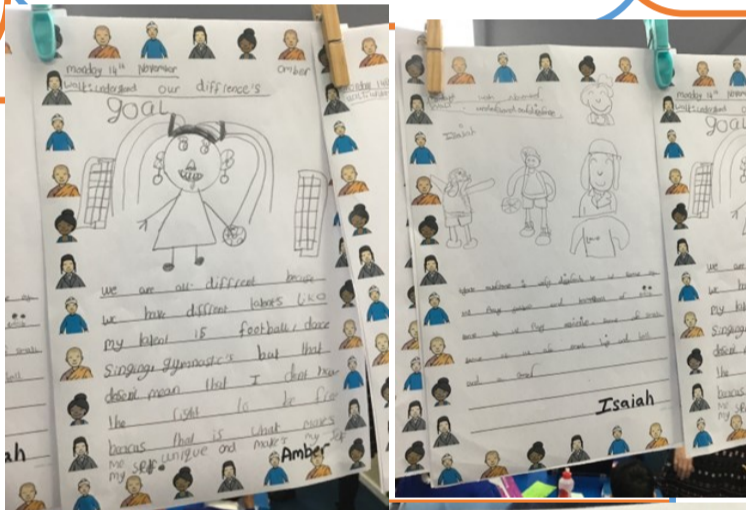
Mindfulness Colouring

Pupils got creative during anti-bullying week and created some beautiful posters using different colours within some difficult patterns. These have

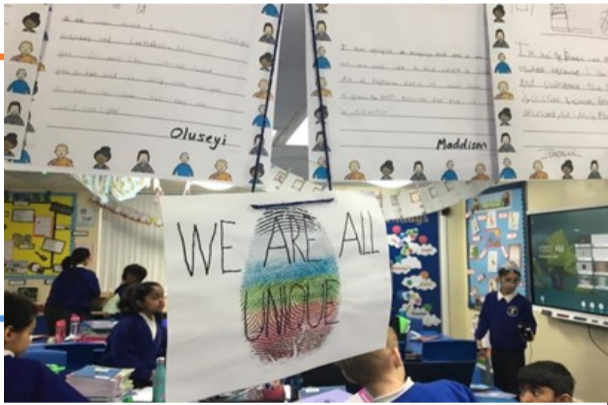


This is me. Being Unique!

The students across year 4 completed an activity all about themselves and what makes them different and unique to others. This was a chance for the pupils to build on

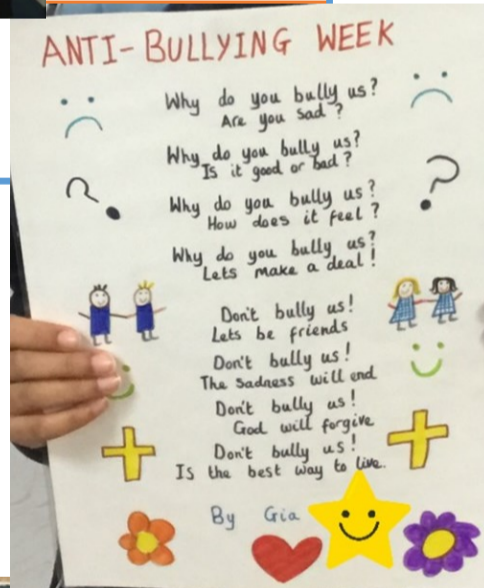
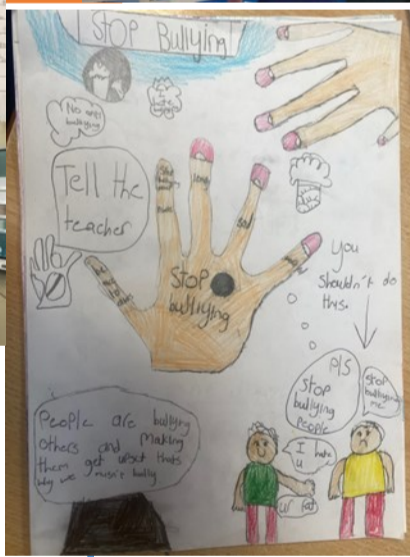

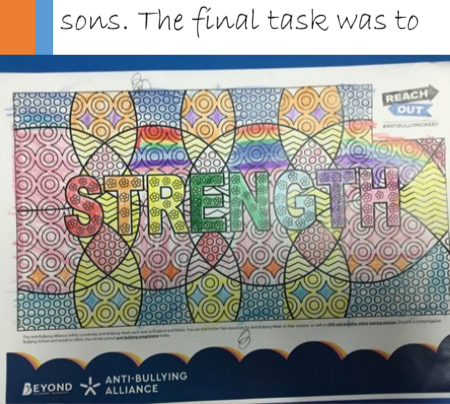
Stop Bullying!
