Lesson I	I hour	What is Easter?	Discuss question. What do children already know about Easter? Mind map in groups of 4. Children can draw or write what they know. Record ideas as a class in pupil books. Watch video. What was the same? What was different about your ideas? Add to ideas and thoughts.	Abbey the owl.
Lesson 2	I hour	The Palm Sunday story. How Jesus was welcomed?	Recap last weeks learning. What do you remember about Intro the first part of the story? What is a palm? Why is it called Palm Sunday? Easter story part I.	Abbey the owl. The Easter story up to Palm Sunday.

Lesson 3	I hour	How Jesus would be welcomed if He came to our school?	.Use PPT. Discuss the emotions and feelings of Jesus, people, priests. Using sequencing images—children write about the first part of the story. Start to learn Palm Sunday song We Sing Hosanna:: Children's Easter Song:: Palm Sunday - YouTube Draw similarities and differences to royal/celebrity visits using pictures. Watch clips such as 'Jesus from Nazareth' and modern day clips of crowds in Jerusalem, walking the same route, to show children that Jerusalem is a real place and Christians today still wave palm leaves and celebrate Jesus' arrival. Read the Easter story and order main events using sequencing cards. Focus on Palm Sunday and recap key questions. TTYP How Christians would welcome Jesus into their town today and why? Continue reading the Easter story including the death and resurrection of Jesus. Talk about His resurrection. Does this show He was special? Lesson 5	I hour	The Easter story (cont.).	TTYP Why was Jesus welcomed like a king or celebrity by the crowds on Palm Sunday? Explain that people welcomed Him because He was special and they wanted to be near Him because they had heard of all the good things He had done. They were also hoping He would be able to help them be free as they were living under Roman rule.	Abbey the owl. Sequencing cards from last lesson.
			TTYP Did he look/behave like a king? Did Jesus want to be welcomed in this way? Do you think Jesus would have preferred a quitter entry to Jerusalem?	
			Recap the Easter story using the cards with the main events form last session. Remind them that Christians believe Jesus is the son of God. Jesus arrived as a king but did He leave as one?	
			Discuss what children have learnt form the story and anything they may find puzzling or questions they may have. Remind them about salvation (Jesus' death and resurrection effect the rescue/salvation of humans. Through Jesus sin is dealt with, forgiveness offered and the relationship between God and humans is restored.).	
Lesson 6	I hour	Who would you welcome in a big way and why is this person worthy of such welcome?	Use Activity Sheet 3 pg. 62 (Discovery RE YI Spring 2) and ask children to draw a picture of someone they really admire/respect, someone they would welcome in a big way if they visited.
