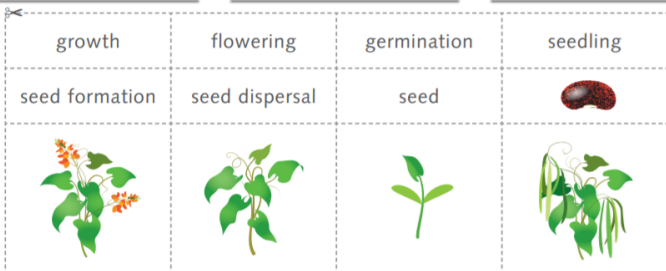
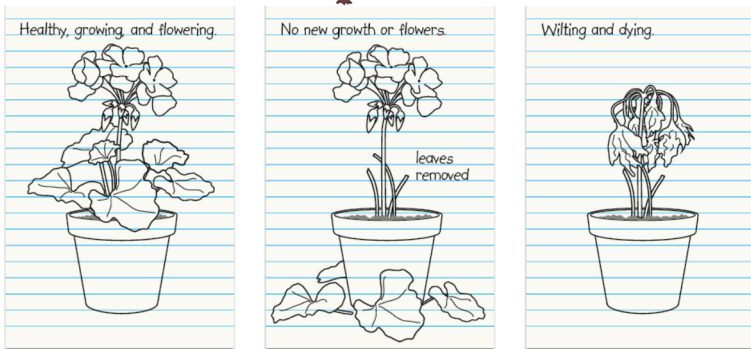
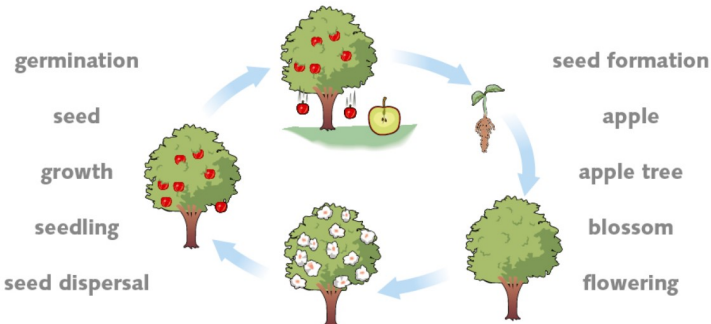

## Reproduction Vocabulary

- 1 Sepal Each of the parts of the calyx of a flower,
- 2 Carpel The female reproductive organ of a flower.
- 3 Stamen The male fertilizing organ of a flower.
- 4 Anther The part of a stamen that contains the pollen.
- 5 Filament A slender threadlike object or fibre, especially one found in plant structures.
- 6 Stigma The ovule producing part of a flower.
- 7 Style A structure found within the flower. It is a long, slender stalk that connects the stigma and the ovary.
- 8 Ovary A female reproductive organ in which eggs are produced .

## Vocabulary

1	Leaflet	Each of the leaf like structures that together make up a compound leaf.
2	Veins	The vascular tissue of the leaf.
3	Lobes	A part into which a leaf is divided.
4	Germination	The development of a plant from a seed or spore after a period of dormancy.
5	Pollination	The transfer of pollen to a stigma, ovule, flower, or plant to allow fertilization.
6	Dispersal	The action or process of distributing or spreading things.
7	Trunk	The main woody stem of a tree as distinct from its branches and roots.
8	Nutrients	A substance that provides nourishment essential for the maintenance of life and for growth.
9	Seedling	A young plant.
10	Mature plant	Plants that have grown to their full height.
